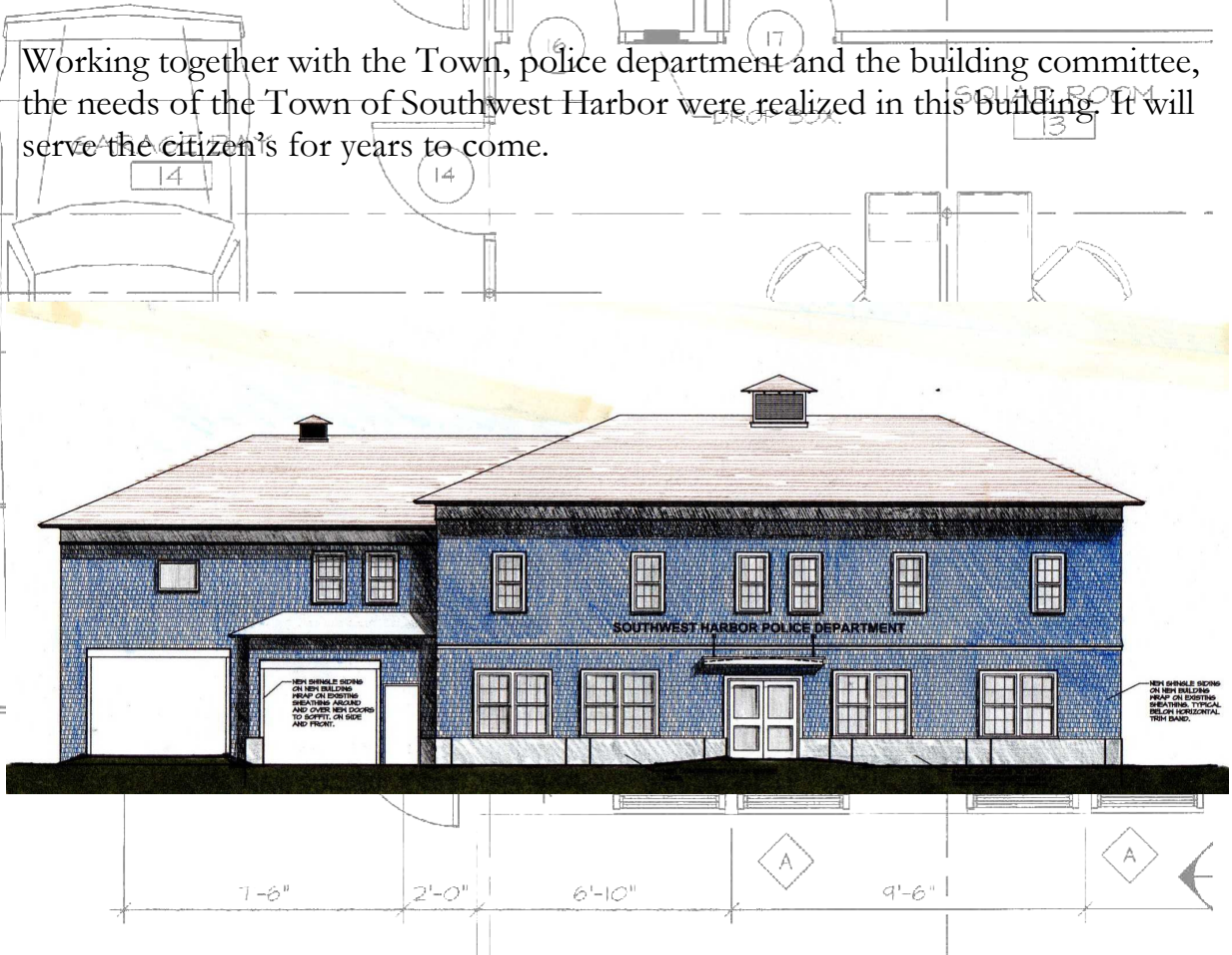


Police Department Renovations

Southwest Harbor, Maine

The Southwest Harbor Police Department was operating in a small, outdated portion of the existing Town Offices along with the Fire Department. With the construction of a new fire station the opportunity to renovate the entire bottom floor of the existing building into the Police Department became evident. The expanded space includes new dispatch facilities, offices for the Police Chief and Lieutenant as well as a squad room for officers. The floor is now A.D.A. compliant, has built-in security features and bullet resistant glazing installed to protect members of the department.

Working together with the Town, police department and the building committee, the needs of the Town of Southwest Harbor were realized in this building. It will serve the citizen's for years to come.
